3. DESCRIPTION OF THE VISIT

Thursday, October 15th

After a welcome speech on behalf of the Coordinator of migration policies of the province of Granada, Mr. Manuel Ruiz and a short presentation of each one of the project participants, Mr. Ruiz, whose competences are basically to facilitate the integration of the regional administration initiatives with local authorities and ngo's in the field of migration, realised a briefing on the migration reality of Andalusia and specially focused on immigrants in the Granada province. Rumanian together with the Moroccan citizens constitute the largest immigration population in Andalusia.

After this presentation, the Ombudsman of the city of Granada, who was the former director of a well known local newspaper (El Ideal), and works as the mediator in the different conflicts between the citizens of Granada (and immigrants) and the municipality, explained the different issues arising from the integration of Rumanian nationals in Granada. He spoke mostly about the Roma population, thus this is the group that requires most intervention from the public services.

The late morning was dedicated to the Weblog, where Ms. Olaru explained the steps undertaken for the creation of the blog and the various contents so far introduced on the platform. Moreover, different decisions were taken in order to improve the blog and disseminate the platform among associations and all interested parts in the project.

The group visited the office of Scierter España in the installations of the Chamber of Commerce of Granada and later went to see a pilot project of the Red Cross "Solidarity Networks" whose activities are focused on the vulnerable area of Granada north which counts with a high presence of immigrants. The weblog steering committee was received by the provincial coordinator of the Red Cross, Mr. Francisco Gonzales who explained the project and its intervention areas such as community, labour, education, training and sensitization.

Friday, October 16th

Raquel Martinez Chicón, project officer at the Directorate General for the Coordination of Migration Policies (Ministry of Employment of the Regional Government of Andalusia) provided more detailed information on the government structure, competences and politics related to migration issues.

Furthermore, Ms. Martinez presented the Forinter project dealing with intercultural training for all professionals who in their daily work deal with immigrants.

The second part of the morning was dedicated to the Weblog progress where the partners agreed that the blog is sufficiently developed (although some information concerning the language courses has to be completed). Therefore, the priority from now on is to concentrate our efforts on the dissemination of the Weblog in order to improve the knowledge about its existence among the immigrant population in Spain as well as Italy.

4. FUTURE COLLABORATION OF THE WEBLOG ASSOCIATION

The partners discussed about the possibilities of a future collaboration and funding opportunities for the continuation of the project approach and the mutual knowledge which has been reached thanks to this Association Project. Therefore, we should try to maximize the effective results achieved by the partnership taking into account the exchange nature of the project.

The partnership agrees that it is necessary to continue in this line, proposing more elaborated projects in the field of the Lifelong Learning Programme.
